Important notes:

- a) The four basic courses are :
 1. Fire prevention and Fir Fighting course,
 2. Personal survival Techniques
 3. Personal Safety & Social Responsibility
 4. Elementary First Aid.

(Basic courses must be DG Approved)
- b) For all courses, 2 number recent photographs, passport size (30 mm x 40 mm) are to be carried.
- c) Passport and CDC must be valid during the tenure of the course.
- d) Photocopies of all the required documents are to be carried.
- e) 100% attendance is compulsory for all courses.
- f) Participants must wear decent informal dress inside the campus during the course.
