#### **SPG** strength reduced drastically



Nonetheless the Yadavas could not withstand the marauding fury of Allaudin Khiliji in the early years of the 14th century and Devagiri became a vassal state of the Delhi Sultanate. In 1317, it was absorbed into that empire.

successor of Allaudin, Sultan Muhammad bin Tughlag decided to make it the capital of his empire. The people of Delhi were forced to leave their homes and resettle in Devagiri which was now renamed Daulatabad. Many perished on the 40-day journey from the old capital to the

Twelve years later, the Sultan realised he had made a mistake and returned to Delhi. In 1347, the nobles of the Deccan rebelled

against the Sultanate. They seized Daulatabad and swore allegiance to Allaudin Bahman Shah, the first of the Bahmani rulers.

In Delhi, the sultanate gave way to the Mughals. The great Akbar tried to capture Daulatabad but in vain. His grandson, Shah Devagiri became famous in 1326 when a Jahan, continuing the offensive, bribed his way into the massive fortress, in 1633.

> The Mughals held on to Daulatabad for more than a century. Aurangzeb who spent the last 25 years of his life in the Deccan, fighting the Marathas, shuttled between Aurangabad and Daulatabad. It eventually fell to the Marathas, in 1760

> In the early 19th century, the Marathas, torn apart by political feuds, surrendered the fort to the Nizam of Hyderabad. Daulatabad remained a part of Hyderabad

state until the reorganisation of states in 1956. Then it was merged into Maharashtra.
