**Sub: Intimation under Regulation 30 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015.**

In continuation to our earlier disclosure on 07.03.2024 and pursuant to Regulation 30 read with Schedule-III of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, we hereby notify the following update:

The Ministry of Ports, Shipping and Waterways (MoPSW) vide Order No. SS-11035/1/2024-SU dated 05<sup>th</sup> May 2025 has conveyed that the Disciplinary Authority in this case, in exercise of the powers conferred under The Shipping Corporation of India Limited Conduct, Discipline & Appeal Rules, 2011 (SCI CDA Rules) has imposed a major penalty of "Dismissal from service which will be a disqualification for future employment under the Government or the Corporation/Company owned or controlled by the Government" in terms of Rule No. 23 (j) of SCI CDA Rules upon Shri C.I. Acharya.

The above Order is subject to further approval of the ACC.

It has been further stated in the above Order of MoPSW, that Shri C.I. Acharya may file an appeal against the aforesaid order to the Appellate Authority in accordance with The Shipping Corporation of India Limited Conduct, Discipline & Appeal Rules, 2011, within a period of one month from the date of receipt of final decision of ACC.
